



FELINE BOARDING CHECKLIST

Vaccinations & Health Requirements

- My cat is current on the Rabies Vaccine (one, two or three year)
- My cat is current on the Distemper Combination Vaccine
- My cat is current on the Leukemia Vaccine (required every year) or has a negative leukemia test within 1 year (indoor cats) or 3 months (outdoor cats)
- My cat has had a negative Fecal Parasite Screen (required every 6 months)

NOTE: With all vaccinations it is best to have them done two weeks or more before boarding. This gives the cat's body time to develop immunity. (Minimum time: 72 hours)

- My cat is using flea protection that is one of the following: Activyl or Frontline or Revolution (Please no flea collars)
- I have sent records from my vet confirming vaccinations and fecal results.

NOTE: Your cat will not be allowed to board with us until all requirements are met for the safety of all boarding cats.

- My cat is healthy. If your cat is coughing, vomiting, sneezing, has discharge from their nose/eyes, is having diarrhea or has anything that can be transmitted from one cat to another. You should make other arrangements for your cat. If they come in and are found to have anything from the above list, they will be separated from all other cats and be charged an extra handling fee.

Paperwork

Medical records and registration forms must be sent to AWC at least 72 hours prior to stay.

- I have completely filled out and packed my Registration for Cats (if this is the first time your cat is boarding) or Frequent Guest Registration (if your cat has boarded with us before).

All paperwork can be found on our web site www.animalwellnessMG.com under the forms tab

NOTE: If you have multiple cats please fill out the Registration for Cats for each cat.

Food

- I have packed enough pre-packaged servings of his/her food to last the length of the stay.
- I have packed my cat's favorite treats (This will help stimulate eating if needed)

NOTE: It is a good idea to pack a little extra food in case your plans change. There is no need to bring bowls for food or water unless you feel your cat will not eat or drink out of our bowls.

Medications & Supplements

- I packed all medications my cat may need while at the Resort and Spa. Please keep medications in original bottles with a legible label
- I packed instructions on how/when to administer my cat's medications

NOTE: If your cat has problems with dirty eyes or ears you can pack eye wipes and ear cleaner for the staff to use when needed

Toys & Bedding

- I packed my cat's bed/blanket (machine washable)
- I packed my cat's toys (machine washable)

NOTE: If we notice your cat is chewing his/her toys or bedding we will take them out of the condo for their safety.
