



CANINE BOARDING CHECKLIST

Assesment

- My dog has completed their trial day prior to boarding stay

Vaccinations & Health Requirements

- My dog is current on the Rabies Vaccine
(one, two or three year)
- My dog is current on the Distemper Combination Vaccine
- My dog is current on the Bordetella Vaccine
(required every 6 months)
- My dog has had a negative Fecal Parasite Screen
(required every 6 months)

NOTE: With all vaccinations it is best to have them done two weeks or more before boarding. This gives the dog's body time to develop immunity.

- My dog is using flea and tick protection that is one of the following: Frontline, Advantix, Vectra 3D, Sentinel, Activyl or Revolution (Please no flea collars)
- I have packed records from my vet confirming vaccinations

NOTE: Your dog will not be allowed to board with us until all requirements are met for the safety of all boarding dogs.

- My dog is healthy. If your dog is coughing, vomiting, has the oral papilloma virus (warts in mouth), has discharge from nose/eyes, is having diarrhea or has anything that can be transmitted from one dog to another you should make other arrangements for your dog. If they come in and are found to have anything from the above list they will be separated from all other dogs, and be charged an extra handling fee.



Paperwork

Medical records and registration forms need to be sent to AWC at least 72 hours prior to reservation

- I have completely filled out and packed my Registration for Dogs (if this is the first time your dog is boarding) or Frequent Guest Registration (if your dog has boarded with us before).

NOTE: If you have multiple dogs please fill out the Registration for Dogs for each dog.

- Completed forms and vaccination records have been sent to AWC by fax 763-420-2194, emailed to boarding@animalwellnessmg.com or dropped off in person, at least 72 hours prior to reservation.

Food

- I have packed enough pre-packaged servings of his/her food to last the length of the stay.
- I have packed my dog's favorite treats

NOTE: It is a good idea to pack a little extra food in case your plans change. There is no need to bring bowls for food or water unless you feel your dog will not eat or drink out of our bowls.

Medications & Supplements

- I packed all medications my dog may need while at the Resort and Spa. Please keep medications in original bottles with a legible label
- I packed instructions on how/when to administer my dog's medications

NOTE: If your dog has problems with dirty eyes or ears you can pack eye wipes and ear cleaner for the staff to use when needed

Toys & Bedding

- I packed my dog's bed/blanket (machine washable)
- I packed my dog's toys (machine washable)

NOTE: If we notice your dog is chewing his/her toys or bedding we will take them out of the room for their safety.
